

Instructions for completing the Application Form

- Please state clearly the degree and subject for which you are applying. If you have already taken your first degree, please include full details of it and of employment or other activities undertaken to date.
- You should request the institution that awarded your main entry qualification (e.g. Bachelor's or Master's degree) to provide a transcript or letter certifying your award. This should be returned by the institution to the University of Kent at Brussels. If you are awaiting results at the time of application, you should request that this information be forwarded to the University when available.
- You should nominate two academic referees who are familiar with your academic abilities. All references must be in English. The University needs to receive both referees' reports before a decision on your application can be made.
- Please ensure that referees seal their original letters of reference, sign the envelopes across the seal to ensure confidentiality, and return them to the University
- If your native language is not English you will be required to submit evidence of your competence in written and spoken English, preferably a satisfactory International English Language Test result (IELTS) or Test of English as a Foreign Language Certificate (TOEFL). If you already have either of these certificates, please submit it with your application.

Photocopied documents are not acceptable unless they have been officially certified.
