When sealing the envelope, the referee should sign across the seal. Please note that we do not regard open testimonials as a satisfactory substitute for confidential references. You should make sure that the names of the two referees are given at the bottom of the first page of the application form, as we may need to contact them for further information.

It is **most important** that these references are attached to your application as without them your application cannot be processed speedily.

If you have a degree, diploma, professional or other qualification awarded by a university, college (or similar institution outside the UK), you should enclose with the application forms a transcript or worksheet of your previous studies.

7 Employment and work experience

It is important to include details of employment and work experience relevant to your application, particularly if your qualifications are not from the United Kingdom or if it is some years since you attended a course of study. If necessary, include such information in your Additional Statement.

8 International applicants

Level of English

The University welcomes applications from students from other countries, but needs to be sure that every student can cope with the linguistic requirements of their chosen programme. Applicants are asked to provide evidence of their competence in English at an early stage in the application process. Please include on this form the results of any English Test already taken, for example the British Council's International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or a TOEFL result.

If you have not taken an English Test you should arrange to take a test (we greatly prefer the IELTS test) as soon as possible, and forward the results to the Faculty Admissions Office concerned. However, you should not delay sending in this application form until you have your test result. The normal minimum standard expected in each of the components of the IELTS test for the Faculty of Arts and Humanities, Economic and Social Sciences, and the Institute of Education is a score of 7.0 (6.5 for English Language Teaching and Applied Linguistics). The minimum acceptable TOEFL score is 590 (243 in the computer-based test), with a score of 500 in the Test of Written English. For the Faculty of Science and Life Sciences the normal minimum standard expected in each of the components of the IELTS test is a score of 6.5 for all programmes (with the exception of MSc in Speech and Language Therapy which requires a score of 7.5 overall with a minimum of 7.0 in any one band). The minimum acceptable TOEFL score is 590 (243 in the computer-based test) with a score of 500 in the Test for Written English. Applicants whose competence falls short of the required standard will be asked to attend an English language programme before beginning the degree or diploma programme. The University provides English programmes of this kind for more than two hundred students every year.
